TASTING NOTES:

Riesling, one of our “noble grapes,” makes especially good wines in Idaho with our combination of long, cool nights, warm days and volcanic soils. Aromas of apricot, ripe pear, and flower blossoms. Bright fruit and slightly sweet, but nicely tart on the finish.

VINEYARD: Sawtooth

FERMENTATION:

This wine was whole cluster pressed, then fermented cool to preserve the fruit characteristics. Fermentation was stopped with slight residual sugar making a wine that has intense fruit and a nice balance of acidity.

BLEND: 100% Riesling

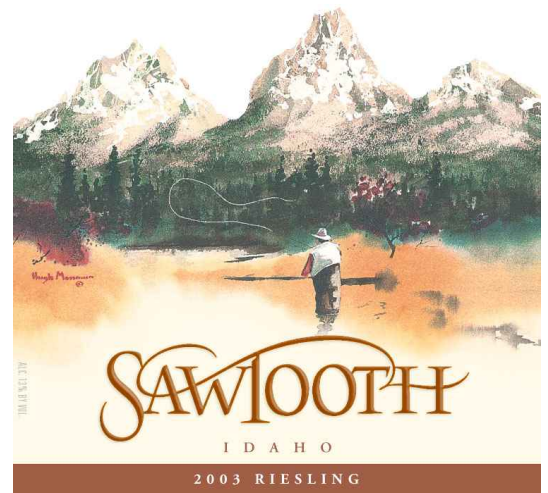
