

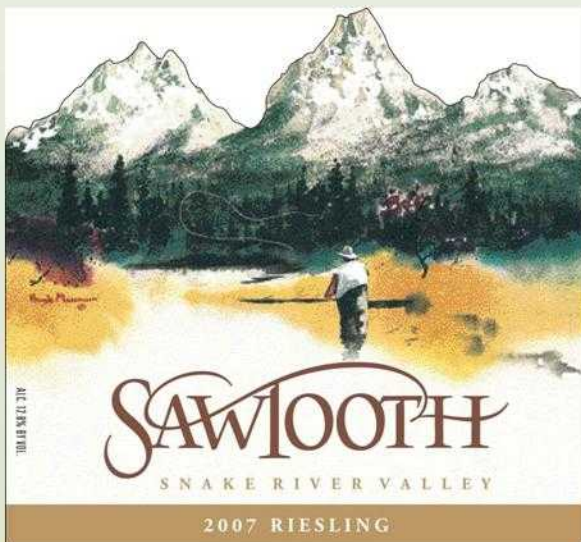

An ideal wine as an aperitif or with light cheeses.
